

Checklist for submitting a doctoral dissertation at the Thuringia University and State Library Jena

According to the general provisions laid down in the doctoral guidelines of the faculties at the Friedrich-Schiller-University Jena from 5 July 2017

Royalty modalities

- 3 printed copies and an identical electronic version for the digital publication in the Digital Library Thuringia. Under the following link you will find our upload form:

- 8 printed copies

General

Listing reviewers and date of defense

Along with the date of defense, all reviewers must be listed with their academic title, name and surname and workplace in each copy on the back of the title page.

Declaration of Authorship

Each copy must include a signed declaration of authorship bound with the rest of the manuscript.

Curriculum Vitae

Including a CV is optional. To protect your personal data, we advise against including your CV in the electronic version of your dissertation.

Medical students

Please enclose a copy of a letter of completion of doctoral examination procedures.

Printing formats

DIN A4 or DIN A5, printed single- or double-sided on standard age-resistant paper.

Binding

Adhesive binding is mandatory. No spiral, velo or springback binding.

Colour or black-and-white printing

The review and depository copies must be identical.

Thesis by publication

A thesis by publication (article thesis) is a dissertation that consists of already-published articles from journals bound together.

Dissertation Note

Note on the back of title page:

Zugl.: Dissertation, Friedrich-Schiller-Universität Jena, [year]

Is enrollment required for graduation?

No, you can receive your doctorate after exmatriculation.

Electronic version

When submitting a dissertation electronically, agreeing to the Declaration (see attachment) is mandatory.

Please submit your dissertation as a standard PDF/A file to upload:

File type

Please publish your dissertation as a PDF/A file ([Information on PDF/A](#)). Make sure all security settings such as password protection are disabled. If your dissertation requires you to supplement other file types (such as video or audio MPEG, AVI or WAV files), please contact us.

File name

Choose a short file name in lower case letters without special characters, umlauts or spaces.

Correct: dissmueller.pdf

Wrong: Title and Topic_Jürgen Müller.pdf

Curriculum vitae (privacy)

Once a dissertation including a CV is published electronically, no more changes can be made to the file.

Publication

After your submitted file and its metadata are reviewed, your dissertation will be made available in the Digital Library Thuringia, entered into the library catalogue. Publishing also gives your dissertation a unique and persistent internet address in form of a DOI.

In addition, your dissertation will be published on the German National Library's archival server.

Publishing electronically will enable your dissertation to be found through search engines.

Submission in person or by mail

Please submit your dissertation to the Central Information Desk at the main library building Monday till Friday between 9.30 and 15.30, or call ahead for an appointment. If you hand in your copies in person, you will immediately receive a note of confirmation for the Dean's office. If you mail in your copies, we will send the confirmation directly to the Dean's office and you will receipt per E-Mail.
